## PIANO SHOWCASE SUNDAY, APRIL 27<sup>TH</sup>

The SLO County Jazz Federation is proud to present its 25<sup>th</sup> annual (wow!) Piano Showcase. This “Jazz Piano Extravaganza” is scheduled for Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, at the Unity Concert Hall, 1490 Southwood (at the corner of Johnson Ave.) in San Luis Obispo. The show will begin at 7:00 pm.

At press time we have seven confirmed pianists with several other possible players yet to be heard from. Along with newcomer **Steve Carlton** will be Showcase veterans **Larry Arone, Jim Barnett, Bob Harway, Rod Keif, Paul Rinzler** and **Gary Ryan**. **Ken Hustad** and **Darrell Voss** will once again provide their stellar rhythm section support.

Tickets (at the door) are \$12 for Jazz Fed members, \$15 for the general public, and a very special student price of just \$5. As always, the proceeds benefit our Scholarship Program, and it should be noted that the pianists donate their time and incredible talents for this very special event.

## YOUNG JAZZ CONCERT SATURDAY, APRIL 12<sup>TH</sup>

The San Luis Obispo County Jazz Federation will be presenting its annual Young Jazz Scholarship Concert on Saturday April 12<sup>th</sup>, at 1:00 PM. The concert will take place at Cuesta College, room 7160 (the Band Room).

The Jazz Fed will be awarding six scholarships: Five \$200 scholarships and one \$500 scholarship. The chosen mix is two students from Cal Poly, two students from Cuesta College and two students of high school age or younger. The \$500 **Matt Taylor** Scholarship is sponsored by **George Taylor** in the name of his late son who was a well-known and well-respected local musician.

At the concert, each of these outstanding young players will be performing a solo piece accompanied by a group of local professional musicians. Every year concert attendees are overwhelmed by the abundant talent of these young musicians.

As a special feature, this year's concert is being filmed for later broadcast on “Your Jazz Show,” a TV program sponsored by the SLO County Jazz Federation and shown three times weekly on public access television.

This is an all-ages concert. Tickets are available at the door for a \$5 donation.

## YOUR JAZZ SHOW

The SLO Jazz Federation continues to sponsor the Your Jazz television show, a series of half-hour programs on public access television, hosted by **Dave Becker**. The program features performances by local jazz musicians. It airs on Charter Communications Channel 2 three times a week: Mondays at 2:30 pm, Thursdays at 9:00 am, and Saturdays at 8:30 pm. The same program is repeated at each of the show times, and a new program is introduced to the mix approximately once a month.

The next show to air will be the Luis Munoz Ensemble featuring Costa Rican folk music in a Latin jazz setting. Shows to follow are Jeff Miley's fusion trio “Altered,” The Young Jazz Artist Scholarship Winners, Inga Swearingen and Bill Peterson-Part II, and the Marty Wright Jazzumentary.

### PABLO MENENDEZ CONCERT

A concert featuring the great Cuban jazz guitarist Pablo Menéndez will be presented on Sunday, April 13th at 7:00 pm at the Cuesta College Student Center in SLO. This will be Menéndez's first concert appearance on the Central Coast, although he has lectured here the past two years on his life as an American musician living in Cuba. He is the only musician from the US to be living and working in Cuba, and he has played an active role in the Cuban music scene for over 40 years.

For this concert his band will include local jazz stalwarts **Bob Harway** (piano), **Dylan Johnson** (bass), **Jim Stromberg** (drums), **Dave Solis** (percussion), and **Ron McCarley** (sax/flute). Also featured will be a special guest appearance by Pablo's mother, blues legend **Barbara Dane**. Tickets are \$15.00, \$12.00 for Jazz Federation members, and \$7.00 for students, and are available at Boo Boo Records or at the door.
